The Second Exodus, like the First Exodus, is a liberation from the slavery of the world, the Iron Kingdom. It is a helping hand to the people of God, the church of Christ. Isaiah 11:11 And it shall come to pass on that day, for the second time, with his hand shall acquire the remnant of his people. God is once again going to redeem his people.

In those days there will appear in heaven a sign, the sign of the Lord Jesus. *Matthew* 24:30:31 And then the sign of the son of man will appear in heaven. This sign is a banner, so a banner will appear in Heaven.

Isaiah 5:26. For He will lift up a banner for the heather peoples, from far away, from the ends of the earth, He will whistle them to Himself.

We're actually going to hear a whistle in those days. "And behold, here they come, hurriedly and quickly" No one will want to miss or dawdle to respond to the call. Except for the people who haven't prepared. Matthew 24:30.

As we can read in Isaiah, it will not be a pleasant time on earth around that call. It is the time of judging the heath peoples, the west and Israel.

Jeremiah 30:10. "You, therefore, do not be afraid, my servant Jacob," declares the Lord, "do not be dismayed, O Israel, for I see that I am going to deliver you from distant lands, your descendants from the land of their captivity, so that Jacob may return, have rest, and be without worry. And no one frightens Him. For I am with you, declares the Lord, to deliver you from the destruction of all the heaths to which I have scattered you, but I will not make a destructive end to you, I will rebuke you in moderation, but I will certainly not hold you innocent.

However, God will protect his people from this and bring them together from the four corners of the world and *bring them under his care*.

Matthew 24:31 And he will send forth his angels with a loud trumpet sound, and they will gather together his elect from the four winds. Isaiah 11:12 He will lift up an ensign among the heath nations, and He will gather the outcasts out of Israel, and gather those scattered out of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Isaiah 43:5-7.

Do not be afraid, for I am with you. From where the sun rises and from where it sets, I will gather you together, I will say to the north, Give. And to the south: Don't hold back! Bring my sons from afar. And my daughters from the ends of the earth, every one whom I am called by My name. Whom I created for my glory, whom I formed, yes I have made.

The people who are counted among the people of God, the spiritual Israel, do not have to live as Jews or follow any religion at all. There are tens of millions of descendants of the ten tribes among the population of the world, so it is highly desirable that this news goes out into the world.

In our day it is all men who have accepted the Lord Jesus as Saviour and Saviour, they all belong to the people of God. Ezekiel 20:41 I will delight in you because of the pleasant fragrance, when I bring you out of the nations, and I gather you from the lands among which you are scattered. I will be sanctified by you to the heath peoples.

A pleasant smell: 2 Corinthians 2:14-16. For we are to God a pleasant fragrance of Christ.
